# Revised Form I-9 Now Available

## Revised Form I-9 Now Available <sup>[1]</sup>

USCIS released a revised version of [Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification](#) <sup>[2]</sup>, on July 17. Instructions for how to download Form I-9 are available on the Form I-9 page. Employers can use this revised version or continue using Form I-9 with a revision date of 11/14/16 N through Sept. 17. On Sept. 18, employers must use the revised form with a revision date of 07/17/17 N. Employers must continue following existing [storage and retention rules](#) <sup>[3]</sup> for any previously completed Form I-9.
